Call for Master Dissertations

The articulation of European policies on natural resource governance: the Water Framework Directive, the Marine Strategy Framework and their implications for

- a) coastal land management,**
- b) coastal water management,**
- c) flood defence zones,**
- d) transitional waters (e. g. river deltas).**

Aims of the call for research:

Both, the Water Framework Directive as well as the Marine Strategy Framework explicitly address coastal zones, to some extent flood zones (see also European Directive on flood protection) and transitional waters. The call for research is interested in how these changes in the European regulatory framework are articulated in the different member states throughout their implementation and operationalisation, how differences in their respective implementation can be explained and what may be barriers to implementation, or potential for synergies between these overlapping regimes of resource governance.

What is being offered by the Division of Resource Economics?

The described research agenda requires detailed concretization concerning: research questions, case study selection, country selection, research design and methodology. While interested Master Students will need to be in charge of all major decisions
