Participants of this seminar will deal with **challenges and policies of social and economic development.** Students may chose one of the two options offered:

- Option A (offered by Prof. Brück) makes participants familiar with analytic and policy tools to understand micro-economic development challenges of global relevance, such as poverty and widespread diseases, and possibilities to cope with them.
- Option B (offered by Prof. Weiter) introduces participants to the institutional framework of development co-operation and project implementation. Applicants should have some field experience within at least one institution active in development cooperation.

These options are offered and examined in different formats (see below). The lectures offered in Option A may also be attended by participants of option B. Block seminar and excursion offered in Option B are limited to 12 participants.
