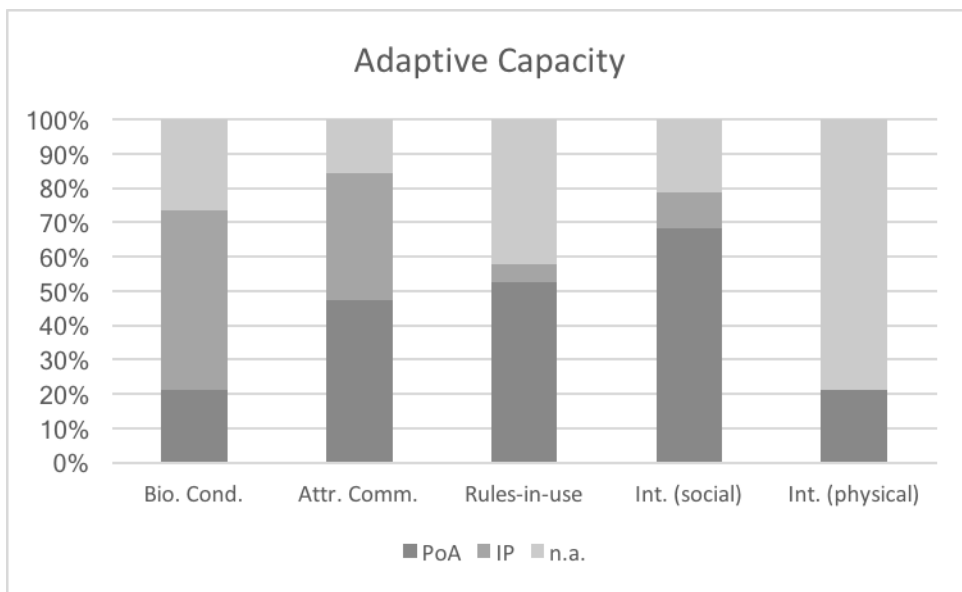


Figure X2: IAD elements within the Adaptive Capacity narrative (n=19)

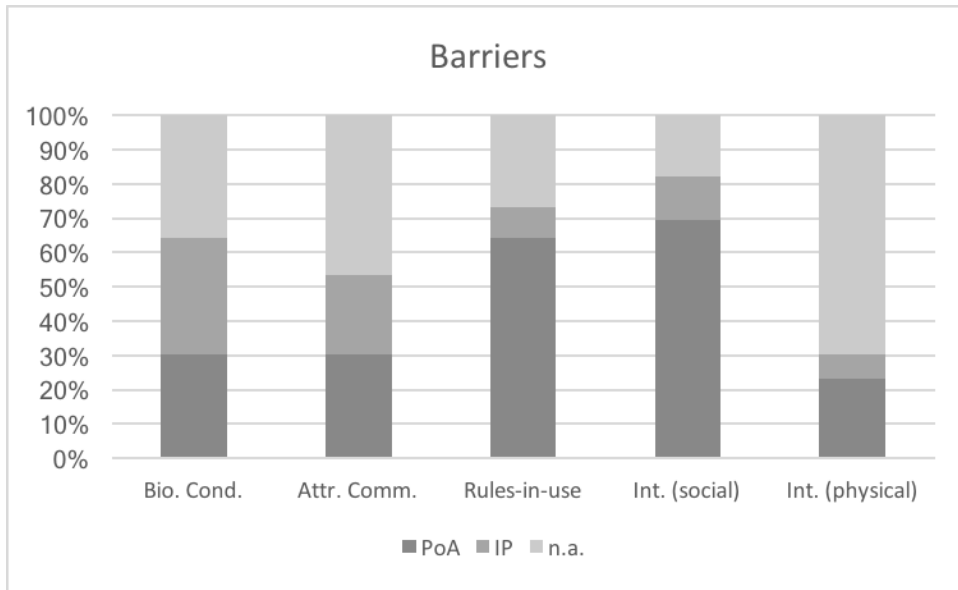


Figure X3: IAD elements within the Barriers narrative (n=56)

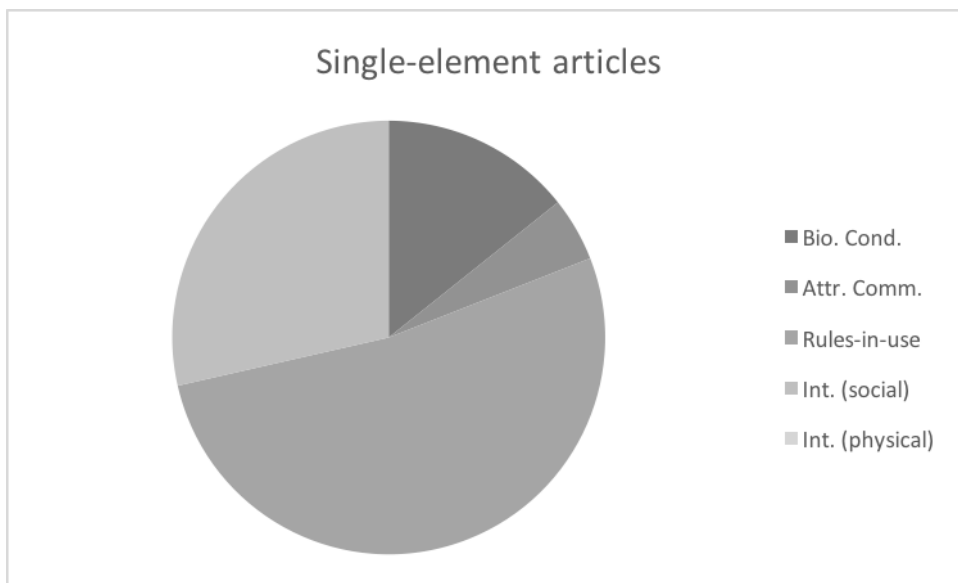


Figure X4: IAD elements in single-element articles (n=56)
