



Paper Writing Workshop, April 6 – 21, 2010

Objective:

In this workshop we aim at discussing and reviewing paper manuscripts of the participants to improve them for publication.

Before the workshop:

All participants have to **hand in a paper draft by 6 April, 10 am**. This paper draft must not be longer than 25 pages but must have an abstract with the central statement of the paper (also required: 1.5 line space, page numbers, and consecutive line numbers). The targeted journal or other place of publication, or other objectives of the paper should be indicated. We will distinguish into groups in respect to the paper topics. Ideal group size is three people. Participation without a complete paper draft is not possible.
