



International Agroecological Summer School 2023

'Agricultural Project Ventimiglia' from 18th to 27th of August 2023

From 18th to 27th of August 2023, the 'Agricultural Project Ventimiglia' inviting you to a Summer School in the Region of Liguria (close to the Cote d'Azur). This summer school will be organized in cooperation with Dieter Franz Obermaier from the Agroecological Living Lab in the Department of Agroecology at the Humboldt University of Berlin.

While last year we dealt more theoretically with the EU agroecological strategy 'From Farm to Fork', the topic of this year's Summer School is the practical implementation of agroecology in horticulture and agriculture. An agroecological project has recently been established in Ventimiglia. Our common task is to develop a first master plan for this newly emerging project.

We will explore the region as well as farms, nurseries and the plant market where we meet producers and finally organize our own public internet event. The beach is also only 30 minutes away by foot. The Summer school will be in English.

Like last year, the overnight stay will take place in your own tent on the project site and we will also prepare the meals ourselves. In case of special requirements please inform the organizers well in advance. The costs for accommodation, food and program will be covered by the project. You are only responsible for your own travelling costs.

If you are a graduate or advanced undergraduate student (second year and up) and would like to apply, please submit your application and supporting documents (CV, letter of motivation) until July 24th via email (dieter.franz.obermaier@hu-berlin.de).

There is a maximum of 14 places available. We will select eligible participants based on the following criteria: motivation letter, CV, English language proficiency (at least level B2 according to the CEFR).
