### Rules for new students (from October 2017 on)

- You will be enrolled under the new study regulations.

### Rules for students currently enrolled under the former regulations

- You may proceed to finalize your studies under the old regulations (for deadlines, refer to the first paragraph of the new regulations).

- You may switch to the new regulations. This change is irreversible and must be filed with the examination office in writing (no e-mail). ### Most important differences between the new and the old regulations

- More uniform compulsory module structure: 5 modules with 6 ECTS credits each.
- Substantially more choice in the focal modules (fachliche Wahlpflichtmodule): Just select 5 out of 28; no further restrictions anymore.
- And for the “free choice modules”:
  - Next to the “modules offered by other study program’s or other departments at Humboldt-Universität as “überfachliche Wahlpflichtmodule” (ÜF)”
  - You may also select any other modules which complement your study program meaningfully
    - From Master Programs of the Thaer-Institute
    - From Master Programs of other faculties at HU zu Berlin
    - From Master Programs of other Universities in Berlin or Potsdam
  - This is under the condition, that you
    - receive consent from the person responsible for the module,
    - apply for this at the Prüfungsausschuss (<https://www.agrar.hu-berlin.de/de/institut/gremien/pa>).
