Admission requirements: To apply for the Master Programme in Agricultural Economics, applicants should hold a Bachelor degree in agricultural sciences, economics or a related Bachelor program. In addition:

- Applicants need to prove a basic understanding of economics through the successful completion of modules with at least 10 ECTS-credits in this field.
- Applicants need to prove basic knowledge of mathematics and statistics through the successful completion of modules with at least 10 ECTS-credits in this field.
- Knowledge of English language at least at C1 level alternatively documented by:
 - Heritage language English
 - Successful graduation from an English language study program
 - UNlcert® III-certificate: 3,0
 - Test of English for International Communication IELTS: 6,5
 - Certificate of Proficiency in English CPE: A-C
 - Certificate in Advanced English CAE: A-C
 - Test of English as a Foreign Language TOEFL:
 - Internet-based Test: 100
 - Paper-based Test: 600
 - Computer-based Test: 250
 - Test of English for International Communication TOEIC: 800
 - London Chamber of Commerce and Industry LCCI Business English: Level 3 with distinction / Level 4 Pass
 - Pearson Test of English PTE Academic: 62
 - DAAD-Sprachzeugnis: Ø mindestens B, kein Ergebnis < C
 - Business Higher BEC: A-C
 - International Certificate in Financial English ICFE: C1 Pass / ~ with merits
 - Business Language Testing Service BULATS: 75+
 - International Legal English Certificate ILEC: C1 Pass / ~ with merits

Not mandatory:

- Work experience (including internships) in the agri-food sector of at least 900 hours. Please file respective certificates from the employer with the application. This will strengthen your application with a weight of 10 out of 100; the final degree of your former study program will count 90 out of 100.
