Introduction

The three EU-ACP collaborative programmes: EDULINK, the ACP Science and Technology Programme (S&T II) and the ACP Caribbean & Pacific Research Programme for Sustainable Development (CP-RPSD), offer opportunities for actors in the ACP higher education and research sectors to address both the structural as well as the scientific and technological challenges faced by ACP Member States. The continued participation of a variety of organisations in these three programmes is extremely impressive and a clear demonstration of the substantial interest amongst the academic and science communities.

The three programmes offer a unique framework for actors, both from the ACP Member States and from across the world to connect and collaborate in a truly global exchange of experiences and know-how in pursuit of the development of equitable knowledge-based societies.

The purpose of the conference is to provide beneficiaries and stakeholders with the opportunity to exchange views on the progress in ACP countries with regards to the scientific divide, Science, Technology and Innovation (STI) capacities, capacity building and regional integration in the field of higher education.

In particular, the conference will provide beneficiaries and stakeholders with the space to reflect and share experiences on the following points:

- the extent to which individual projects have been able to contribute to the achievement of the overall objectives of the three programmes;
- (2) the state of play of STI and Research in ACP countries, and of the capacities of ACP higher education institutions;
- (3) the lessons learnt and the role that beneficiaries and stakeholders will be able to perform, at their respective levels, in a longer term perspective

The conference will run through three phases:

- (1) Exchanges on (expected) results and (prospective) impact;
- (2) Presentation of key issues related to ACP higher education and research institutions' capacities – both from a global and a sectorial perspective;
- (3) Reflection on lessons learnt and presentation of partnership/funding opportunities.
