Requirements for participation:

Students need to be enrolled in either

- M.Sc. Rural Development

...and need to have either completed *or* started with one of the following modules up to the time of the excursion:

- FM 2 European & International Agricultural Policy
- FM 5 International Macroeconomics & International Trade

For completion of the module (6 ECTS), students are required to:

- submit a statement on individual learning goals (600 words) before workshop 1
- prepare and deliver a group presentation (oral exam) during the preparation workshops (30min, max. 4 group members, topics to be announced)
- actively participate in the excursion
- submit a reflection report after the excursion (2.000 words)

Planned activities:

- Visit of the European Commission (DG Agri), European Parliament and the European Council incl. talks with experts
- Visit of the Permanent Representation of the Federal Republic of Germany at the EU incl. talks with experts
- Meeting with Copa-Cogeca
- Workshop with representatives of companies and NGOs at the Office of the State of Berlin at the EU
